Introduction

God's gift of language enables us to communicate thoughts, ideas, information, and feelings. We express these by speaking and by writing. A biblical worldview sees spelling as a tool used to honor God and to love and serve others through writing.

SPELLING 1 (Fourth Edition) focuses on reliable spelling generalizations. This emphasis has produced spellers who are self-confident and have a positive attitude toward spelling and writing.

Each spelling lesson contains a word list and a sentence that the teacher will dictate during the practice and final tests. The spelling words are drawn from word families that have been taught during the phonics lessons found in *PHONICS AND ENGLISH 1* Teacher Edition (Fourth Edition) and are chosen on the basis of their frequency in the student's vocabulary. Because the phonogram or word-family approach is used, the student will be able to spell many more words than those given on his weekly list.

This program is designed to begin Week 4 or 5 in first grade. If you are using *PHONICS AND ENGLISH 1* Teacher Edition (Fourth Edition) from BJU Press, we recommend that you begin the spelling lists after Lesson 15.

This worktext is designed to be completed with teacher guidance. Pages are not intended to be removed.

4. Write the word and say it again.




5. Close your eyes and think of how the word is spelled.
