







FOSSILS TELL US ABOUT DINOSAURS THAT ONCE LIVED UPON THE EARTH.

Dinosaurs were creatures that once lived upon the earth. Most of what is known about dinosaurs has been learned from studying their fossils. Fossils are the hard remains of living things that have been found in rocks. Scientists take great care in digging fossil bones out of the rock that surrounds them. And on rare occasions, they find enough bones to make a complete skeleton. Perhaps you have seen dinosaur skeletons in a museum.

While the giant sea creature above (Tylosaurus) is really a marine reptile, in body weight and in total length, the Tylosaurus (TILE-oh-SAW-rus) rivaled the largest land-dwelling dinosaurs. He measured up to 26 feet long and was completely aquatic. Tylosaurus was created by God on the fifth day of Creation Week (Genesis 1:21) "And God created great whales and great sea monsters" (NASB). Does Tylosaurus look like a great sea monster to you?
