


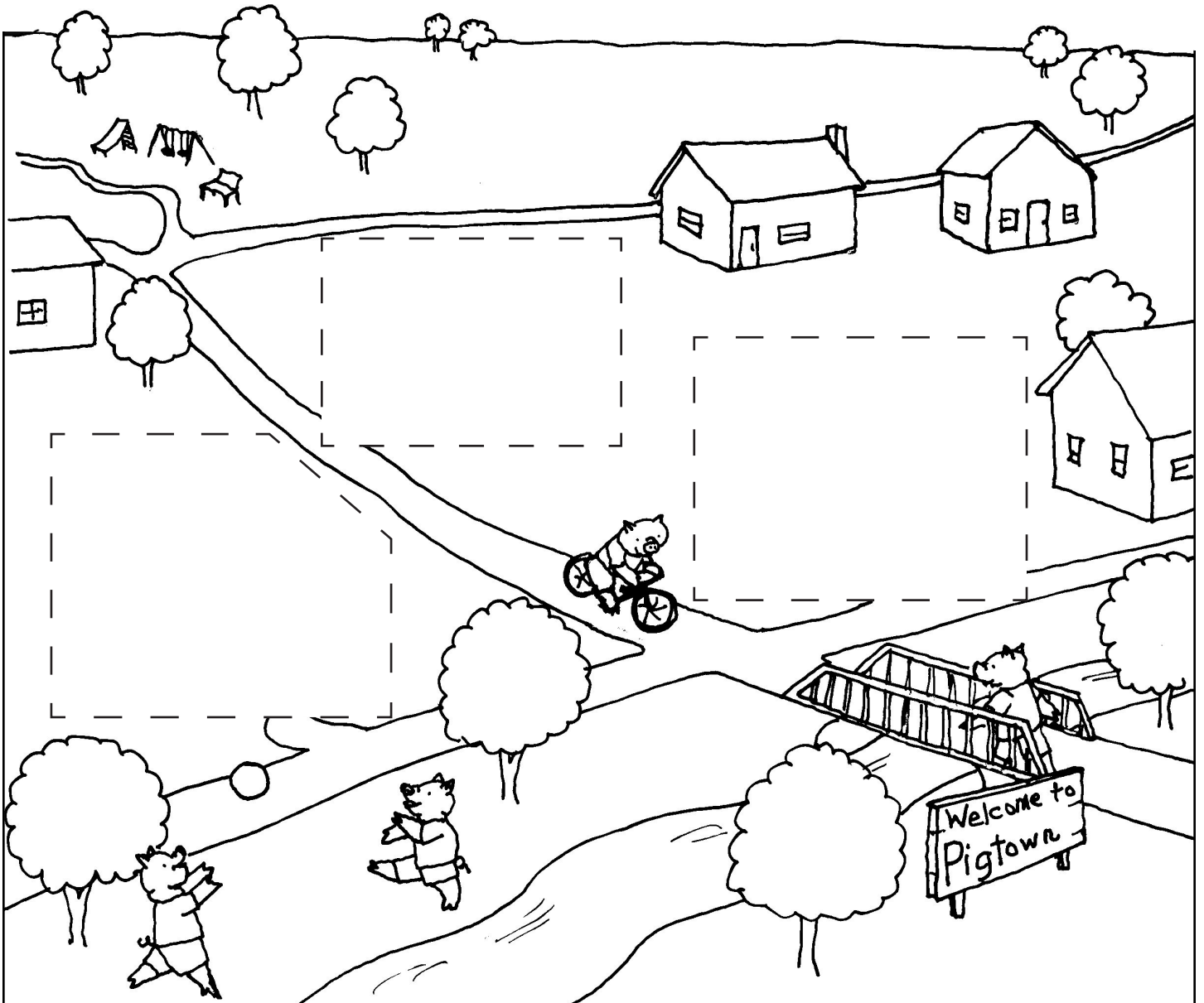


# A View of Pigtown

This is a **side view** of Pigtown.


1. Cut out  the three houses.\*
2. Match the **shape** of each house to its outline.
3. Paste  each house in the picture.
4. Colour  your picture.

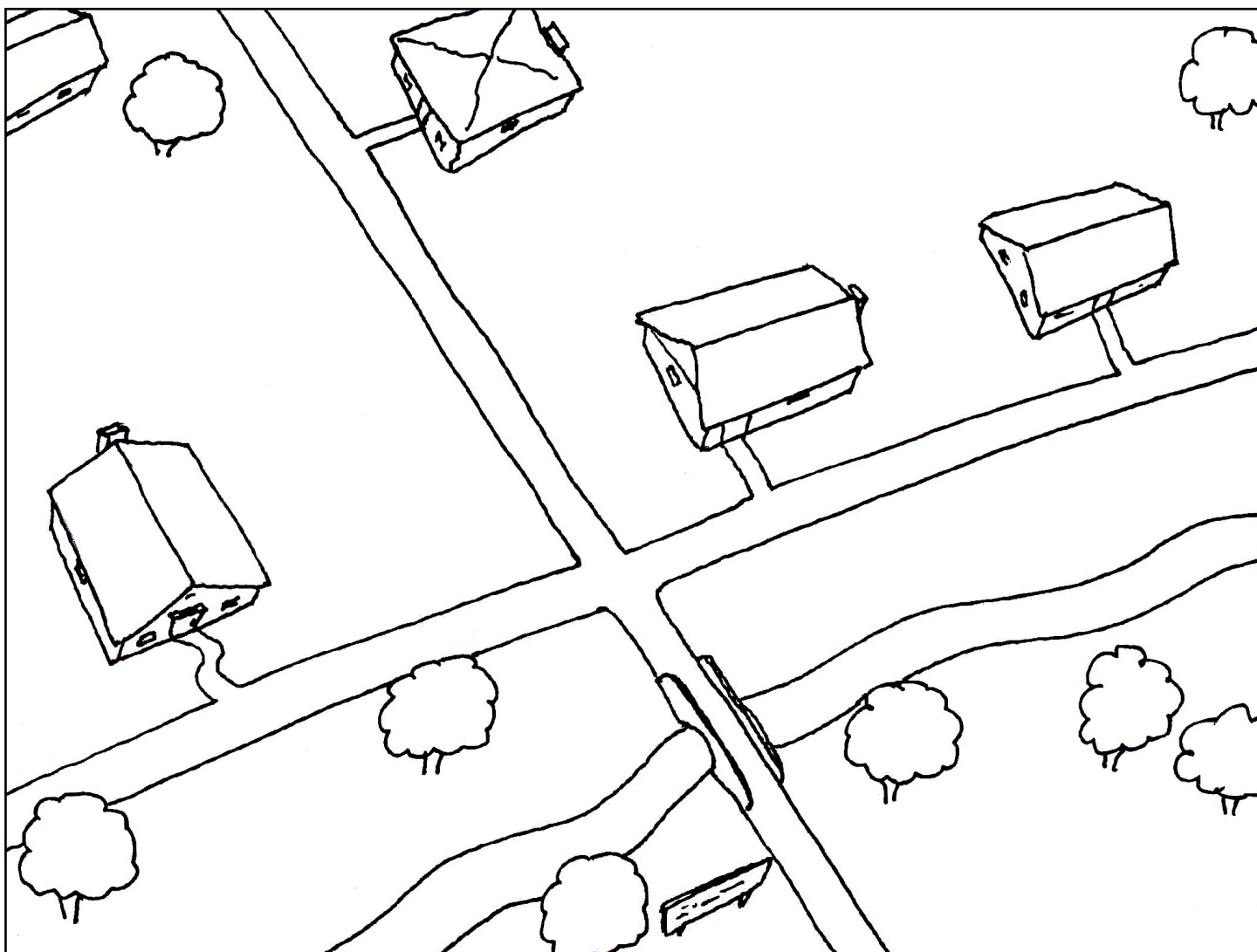


We see most objects from their side view. \*Cut-outs of the houses are on page 31.

# Pigtown From Above

This a **top view** of Pigtown.

1. Put a ① in the picture to show a road.
2. Put a ② in the picture to show a river.
3. Put a ③ to show a bridge.
4. Put a ④ beside the house nearest to the bridge.
5. Put a ⑤ beside the tree that is near a house.
6. Colour  the picture.



This is a top (or bird's eye) view. Have students observe how shapes of objects change from a side view to a top view.
