

The Gentle Giant

“g” as in “giant”
“ies” as in “puppies”

When the letter “g” is followed by an “e”, “i”, or “y”, the “g” makes what is called a “soft g sound”, like we hear in the word “giant”.

To turn a word ending in “y” into a plural word, the “y” is dropped and an “ies” ending is added. The “i” is silent and the “e” will say it’s long sound as in the word “puppies”.
