HELPFUL TIPS

- Art can be a messy process. You may want to designate an old oversized shirt or old apron to be the smock that saves your student's clothes. Each lesson recommends laying out a placemat to protect the surface on which the student is working, but an old or washable tablecloth may be used as well.
- Most skills can be practiced independently; however, some lessons will need parental oversight.
- Parent's Notes are provided to give extra insight into why the student may be doing a certain activity or how you may help them.
- It can take time to acquire the skills needed to create art. Encourage your student not to get frustrated. It can be healthy to take a step back when it becomes too overwhelming.
- Encourage good imagination. Sometimes the most personal art project is nothing more than a pack of crayons, a fun story, and a blank piece of paper.
